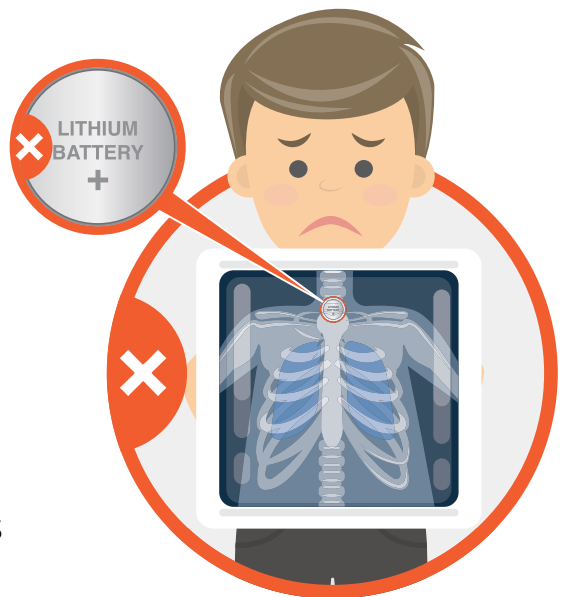


Button Batteries

If swallowed, button batteries can get stuck in a child's throat and burn through the oesophagus in less than 2 hours.

This burning can lead to serious injury, requiring surgery, or death.



If you suspect a child has swallowed or inserted a button battery, **call the POISONS INFORMATION CENTRE on 13 11 26 immediately.**

To prevent button battery related injury



Look for items with button batteries



Keep items and loose batteries out of reach



Secure the battery component



Dispose of them immediately and safely
