Keep medicines and poisons out of the reach of children. Common household items like paracetamol, dishwasher tablets, hand sanitisers, cleaning products and pesticides are poisonous.



If someone swallows or comes in contact with something that might be poisonous, **call the POISONS INFORMATION CENTRE on 13 11 26** and follow their advice.

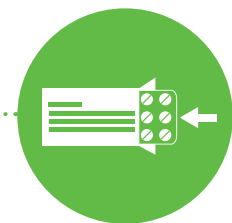
Prevention
